Day 1 Vancouver — Leavenworth — Spokane

Tour departs from Vancouver in the morning to *Leavenworth*—Bavarian-styled village in the Cascade Mountains, central Washington State, the alpine-style buildings with restaurants serving German beer and food line Front Street. Afterwards, we continue our tour to *Dry Falls*, which is 3.5 miles long and about five times the width of Niagara; this dramatic landscape and the plunge pool at the base were formed by Ice Age floods that swept through the area. Leave Dry Falls heading to *Spokane* in central Washington in late afternoon.

Hotel: Fairfield Inn by Marriott Spokane or similar

Day 2 Spokane — Coeur d' Alene — Missoula — Butte — Bozeman (B)

After breakfast travel to the famous vacation resort town of *Coeur d'Alene*. One can enjoy a leisurely stroll along the world's longest floating boardwalk, 3,300 feet long and 12 feet wide. In the afternoon we will enter the state of Montana, visit the famous *50,000 Silver Dollar* gift shop, restaurant and casino. The gift shop is huge, and has a very impressive amount of knives and all sorts of different unique collectibles. Afterwards, drive by *Butte* before arriving *Bozeman* in the evening where we'll spend the night.

Day 3 & 4 Yellowstone Park (Mammoth Hot Springs/Terraces Norris — Artis Points/Grand Canyon/Fountain Paint pot/Grand Prismatic Spring/Old Faithful geyser/Yellowstone Lake/West Thumb/Mud Volcano/Bozeman) (B)

We will spend 2 Days touring the *Yellowstone National Park* which spans an area of 8,992 sq. km. Through the *Roosevelt Arch* at the North Entrance, first visit the Terrace Mountain at *Mammoth Hot Springs* which is the largest known carbonate-depositing spring in the world. The Minerva Terrace has tinted travertine shades of brown, orange, red and green. Lunch at *Canyon Village*, where you can find the Heritage & Research Centre and gift shop. *Artist Points* is the best place for taking photo of the colorful *Grand Canyon*. Norris Geyser Basin is the hottest, oldest and most dynamic of Yellowstone's thermal areas. The geothermal areas of Yellowstone have hot springs, mud pots and fumaroles. The vast majority of the waters at Norris are acidic, including acid geysers which are very rare. *Steamboat Geyser* is the tallest geyser in the world (300 to 400 ft.) *West Thumb* Geyser Basin, on the edge of Yellowstone Lake overlooks *Yellowstone Lake* the largest lake at high elevation in North America. The Yellowstone Lake is 2,376m above sea level and covers 224 sq km. The most famous geyser in the Park, and perhaps the world, is Old Faithful Geyser, located in the Basin. It erupts approximately every 91 minutes. The *Grand Prismatic Spring* is the largest hot spring in the United States, and the third largest in the world and named as a "boiling lake".

Hotel: Comfort Inn, Bozeman or similar

Day 5 Bozeman — Missoula — Spokane (B)

Leaving Bozeman for Missoula, you'll enjoy a *sales tax free shopping* in the States of Montana, lunch en-route. Arrive Spokane in early evening where Expo 1974, the first environmentally themed world's fair, was hosted. The site now become the city's 100 acres Riverfront Park.

Day 6 Spokane — Moses Lake — Duty Free — Vancouver (B)

Leave Spokane heading to the *Moses Lake* to find the floating green, one of the best loved icons in golf. A brief stop at the border for the last minute duty-free shopping before returning to Vancouver.
